## Introduction

This document describes the harvesting format museumdat which serves for providing core data from different collection contexts in common portals sometimes transcending the mere museum context.

*museumdat* is a generalization of the format CDWA Lite - a harvesting format primarily for data from the fine arts - which was developed by the J Paul Getty Trust together with ArtSTOR.<sup>2</sup>

The generalization serves for applicability of the harvesting format to further object classes and has been developed by courtesy and in cooperation with the J Paul Getty Trust. An XSLT Transformation is also available for converting of museumdat-data of fine art objects to CDWA Lite and vice versa. OAI harvester can thus be served by both formats without any further efforts.

*museumdat* is structured into 5 principal categories of documentation<sup>3</sup>, furthermore important is the distinction of presentation elements (II. Identification; III. Description) and indexing elements (I. Classification; IV. Events; IV. Relations). These latter are optimized for retrieval purposes. The elements shall absolutely be used redundantly.

For all elements in the documentation the corresponding CDWA Lite element is indicated. The reference to the CDWA Lite element applies to all sub-elements unless otherwise noted. Sometimes the description has been revised with the objective to clarify it. Wherever there is a difference between museumdat and CDWA Lite element this difference is explained in a footnote – except if only the added attributes *imported*, *encodinganalog*, *label*, *xml:lang* (see description of I.1.1. Object/Work Type for explanation) are the difference. Note also that not all required elements of CDWA Lite are also required in museumdat because of the broader focus of the format.

## Wrapper for the whole document

**Element tag:** <museumdat:museumdatWrap>

**Attribute:** relatedencoding, langencoding, xml:lang

**Note:** The attribute *relatedencoding* contains the source format for the attributes *encodinganalog* and *label* (see I.1.1. Object type). This may be any metadata standard like DublinCore, but also MIDAS, KNORR or system-specific formats. *xml:lang* indicates the language of the whole document, this value may be overwritten by specifying the language attribute in sub-elements. The language encoding scheme is indicated in the attribute *langencoding*. All these attributes are optional.

**Recommended values for langencoding:** ISO 639-2b, RFC 3066 or other encoding schemes may be used.

**Note:** Whenever one of the attributes listed above appears in a museumdat element it should be used as follows:

*termsource* is the name of the controlled vocabulary that is used.

*termsourceID* is the unambiguous key for the term, chosen from this vocabulary

*imported* has the two values: yes | no.

Imported="yes" indicates, that the element contains an additional term which is derived from the termsource (i. g. synonym, generic term, superordinate term) and should be used only for retrieval.

imported="no" is default.

All elements with data values are accompanied by the attributes

*encodinganalog* and *label*, to indicate the format of the data source from which the data were migrated. *encodinganalog* thus refers to the internal field label of the source database; *label* refers to the external label (at the visible user interface). The source format is indicated in

"museumdatWrap".

### I.2.1. Sub-element: Classification

**Element-Tag:** <museumdat:classification>

**Description:** Term used to categorize a work by grouping it together with other works on the basis of similar characteristics. The category belongs to a systematic scheme (classification) which groups objects of similar characteristics according to uniform aspects. This grouping / classification may be done according to material, form, shape, function, region of origin, cultural context, or historical or stylistic period. In addition to this systematic grouping it may also be done according to organizational divisions within a museum (e.g., according to the collection structure of a museum).

If the work is assigned to multiple classifications, repeat this element.

**Attributes:** termsource, termsourceID, imported, encodinganalog, label, xml:lang
